1.0 Staff Understanding of the Proposal

- Proposal enables AFRINIC staff to remove lame delegation records from 'domain' objects in the AFRINIC database, as well as deletion of related objects containing those lame delegations.
- It is an update (or enhancement) to the current rDNS process outlined in the Consolidated Policy Manual (Sec 10)

2.0 Staff Comments:

As of 12 May 2017, reverse DNS space delegated from AFRINIC IP resources is approx 44% LAME according to data analysed from http://ftp.afrinic.net/pub/zones/

4.1 Timeline & Impact

(Software) development and testing will require approximately six (6) months.

4.2 Implementation Requirements

The following actions are necessary to implement this policy as written:

- Implementing the automated "lameness" checks.
- Updating (internal) business rules to run checks prior to domain creation/updates.
- Automation of notifications sent out to contacts of records associated to lame delegations as well any lameness delegation reports.
- Public lameness checker tool.
- Object archival in WHOIS (additional development also be needed to display archived objects in MyAFRINIC).
- Automation of removal of lame delegations.
- Automation of object reinstatements.
- Appropriate internal and external process documentation.
