This is where all information related to registered resources is stored. This includes information about Autonomous System Numbers, IP addresses, organisations that are associated with these resources and related Points of Contact (POC) and routing. The information in the AFRINIC Database is available to the public for agreed Internet operational purposes, but is under copyright. A web interface for whois is now available. You can also query the AFRINIC whois database using a standard whois client pointing to whois afrinic.net (standard TCP port 43). You can, if you don't already have one, download our whois client which gives you more functionalities.
